### **Students Learn from** Women In Business

Toodbury University women are making their mark every day in the business world, as 2008 Women Who Mean Business nominee Dr. Karen Kaigler-Walker demonstrates.

In addition to producing graduates who achieve success in their chosen professions, Woodbury is known for professors who are leaders in their fields. Here's a look at the recent accomplishments of just a few of Woodbury's many talented women:

Dr. Karen Kaigler-Walker, assistant dean of the School of Business and professor of marketing, assisted by Dr. Zelda Gilbert, professor of psychology, conducted a one-day seminar last month on the socio-psychological aspects of fashion and appearance for Funtry, the largest image consulting and training firm in Beijing. Professional image consultants/trainers and members of the Association of Image Consultants International (AICI) came from Shanghai and Dalian, as well as experts from Beijing participated in the event. The day was capped off with a cocktail party at Dress Code, a boutique that showcases fashion forward, young European designers. Similar seminars by Dr. Kaigler-Walker and Dr. Gilbert are planned for October and Spring 2009.

Jeanine Centuori, an architecture professor and a principal in the firm UrbanRock Design, is on the cutting edge of new housing that is expected to become popular in Los Angeles. Her Urban-Rock Design just announced the construction of a four-unit housing project in southeast Hollywood that utilizes the small-lot ordinance, which proposes a new model for development and home ownership by allowing lots as small as 600 square feet and just 12 feet wide. According to Centuori, Los Angeles will now see the first wave of these projects being built in urbanized areas. Unlike typical apartment-style condominiums, these buildings have distinct boundaries between homes. The UrbanRock Design project, located in the dense neighborhood of southeast Hollywood, provides four modern townhouses equipped with two-car carports, state-of-the-art kitchens, fireplaces, backyards and private patios. Every square inch is carefully and efficiently designed in order to make the most of tight spaces.
