Chris Sanford informed the committee that the amount distributed by the CO's office is \$182,156. Crowhurst said there were 106 proposals received and approximately 30 applications will be awarded and money from the quasi-endowment account can also be used towards the RSCA awards.

up for discussion. She mentioned there will be three reviewers assigned to each proposal
