The B.A. degree pathway will provide a student with a B.A. degree in Liberal Studies ONLY and is best suited for students who wish to enroll in a teaching credential program after they earn their bachelor's degree. The ITEP-Junior Option is for students who would like to earn their bachelor's degree and a teaching credential simultaneously. All students begin on the B.A. degree pathway and must satisfy the requirements listed below. Students may apply to ITEP as early as their first semester once Junior standing is achieved. All General Education and Title V requirements are incorporated within the major. **Transfer students should <u>not</u> follow a California State University General Education Certification or IGETC plan**. Information about transfer admission requirements may be obtained from the office of Admissions and Records at www.csun.edu/admissions-records. Liberal Studies information may be obtained at www.csun.edu/liberal-studies.

MAXIMUM ALLOWABLE TRANSFER UNITS: A maximum of 70 semester units may be transferred from a California Community College. Students may exceed the 70 unit limit as long as they complete 50 units at a four-year institution (30 of these 50 units must be completed at CSUN).

LIBERAL STUDIES WORKSHOPS: Transfer students should complete an online workshop one semester before attending CSUN by visiting: www.csun.edu/humanities/liberal-studies/online-workshops. Students who have applied to CSUN, have completed the workshop **and** who have received an evaluation of their record by email may contact the Liberal Studies office to schedule an individual advisement appointment with an advisor.
