

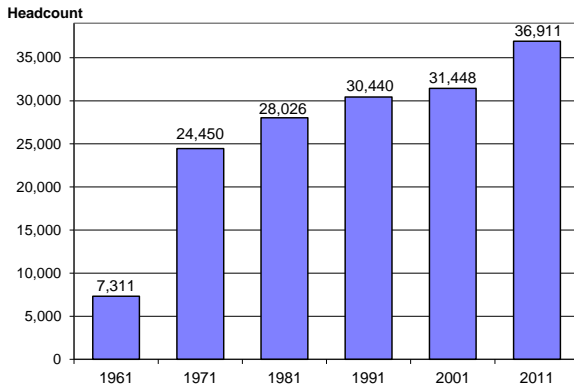

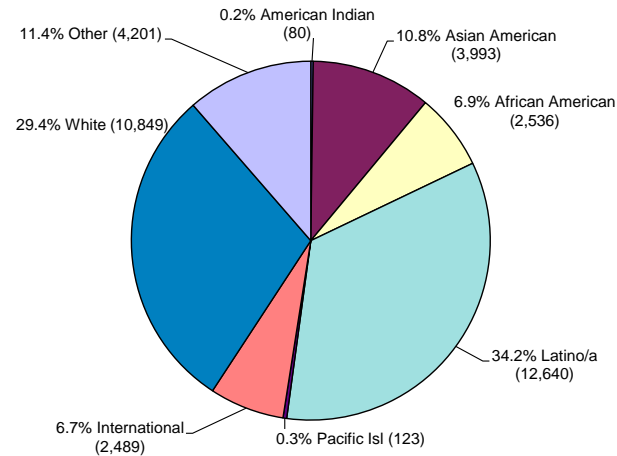

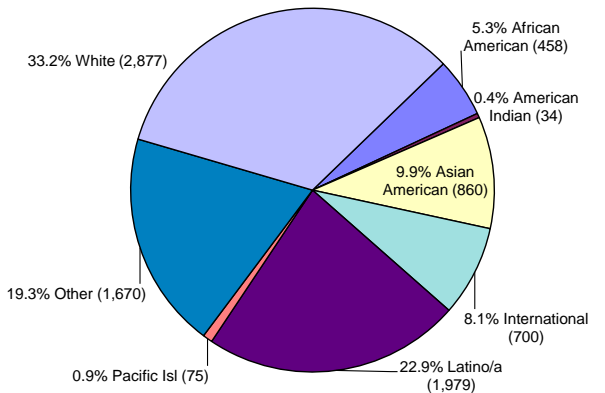

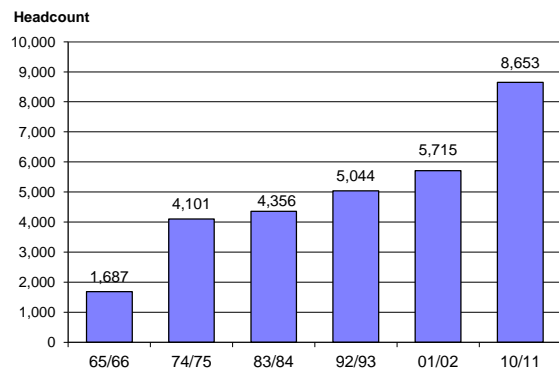

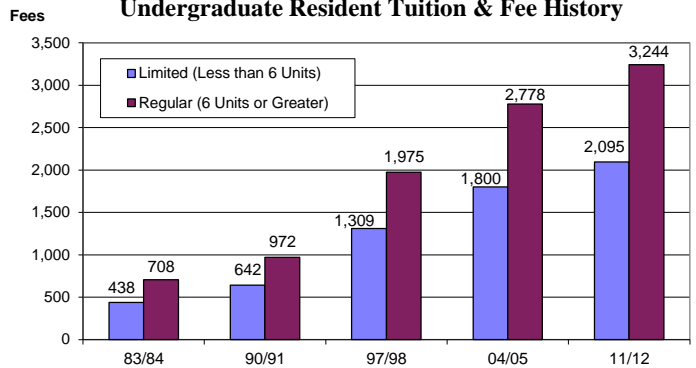

Tuition & Financial Aid 2011/12

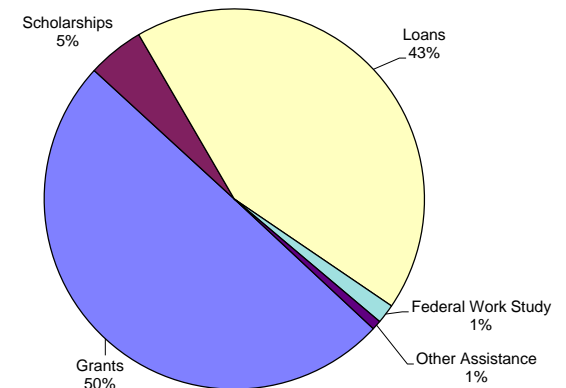
Undergraduate Resident Tuition & Fee History
