

Subject: Application for Sabbatical Leaves during the 2023-24 Academic Year

We are pleased to announce that the sabbatical application will again be online this year and we will be utilizing the Interfolio system for the review process. In order to initiate a sabbatical or DIP application “case” in Interfolio, faculty members will need to request activation using a GoogleForm. Once the faculty member submits their sabbatical/DIP application through Interfolio, the departmental and college reviews will also occur in this same format.

To get the process started, we ask that you review the attached draft list of eligible applicants and confirm with our office whether there are any additions or deletions according to your records.

Once the list is confirmed, we are requesting that you send the following link for the 2023-24 sabbatical leaves or difference-in-pay leaves to eligible full-time faculty in your department.
