This application is for students applying for the BUILD PODER program at CSU Northridge for the 2018-19 academic year. This also includes students transferring from community colleges to CSUN for Fall 2018.

This program is part of a national study on student experiences and career choices funded by the National Institutes of Health. The University of California, Los Angeles (UCLA) serves as the Coordination and Evaluation Center (CEC) for this national effort and is collecting information about the experiences and career choices of a variety of students such as you. Biomedical and STEM student education nationally may benefit from your participation.

By completing this application, you are enrolling in this study and giving permission for your school to share information about you with the CEC at UCLA from your BUILD application, as well as selected information from your school's educational records. Examples of this information include your name, date of birth and the email address you provide on this application. You are also giving your institution permission to give your contact information to the CEC at UCLA so that you can be invited to participate in annual surveys. The CEC at UCLA may also ask you to be part of focus groups and interviews as part of the national evaluation.

ELIGIBILITY

Currently full-time enrolled as a student at CSUN. Or students who will be transferring to CSUN from one of our Partnering Community Colleges:

- East Los Angeles Community College
- Los Angeles Valley College
- Pasadena City College
- Pierce College
- * Must be enrolled as a full-time student at CSUN for 2018-19
- * TRAINES must have completed at least 30 units of college-level courses; SCHOLARS must have completed at least 60 units of college-level courses.
- * Must be enrolled in one of the following majors (see list below) and must have an interest in biomedical research topics (e.g., health and health disparities), and must be committed to earning a doctoral degree (Ph.D. or MD/Ph.D.)
- * Must have a cumulative GPA of 3.00 or higher
- * U.S. citizen, national or permanent resident (unfortunately DACA or Dreamer students are not eligible)

BUILD PODER is interested in encouraging the recruitment and retention of the following classes of students:

- A. Individuals from racial and ethnic groups that have been shown by the National Science Foundation to be underrepresented in health-related sciences on a national basis, including: African Americans, Hispanic Americans, American Indians, Alaska Natives, Native Hawaiians, and other Pacific Islanders.
- B. Individuals with disabilities, who are defined as those with a physical or mental impairment that substantially limits one or more major life activities.
- C. Individuals from disadvantaged backgrounds who are defined as:
 - 1. Individuals who come from a family with an annual income below established low-income thresholds (see 2014 guidelines at http://aspe.hhs.gov/poverty/14poverty.cfm).
 - 2. Individuals who come from a social, cultural, or educational environment such as that found in certain rural or inner-city environments that have demonstrably and recently directly inhibited the individual from obtaining the knowledge, skills, and abilities necessary to develop and participate in a research career.

NOTE: If your major is not listed below, you may be able to enter our "experimental program" for non-science majors which has slightly fewer financial benefits.
