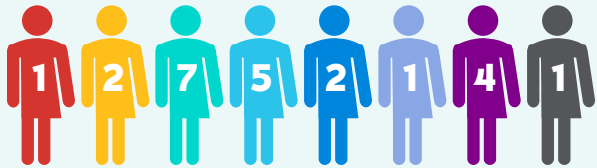

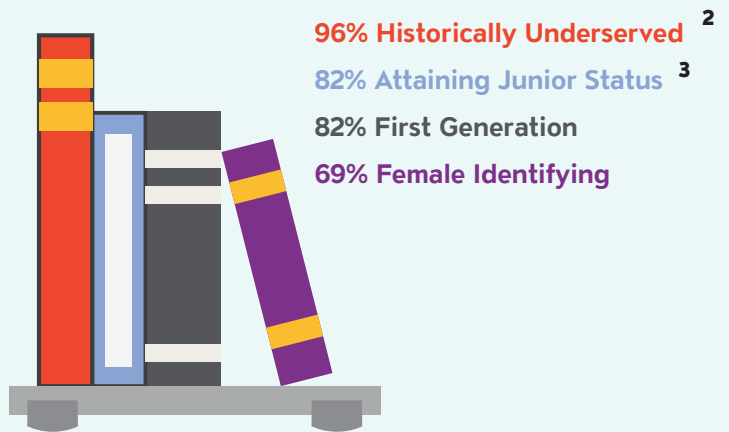

NUMBER OF STUDENTS ENROLLED BY COLLEGE

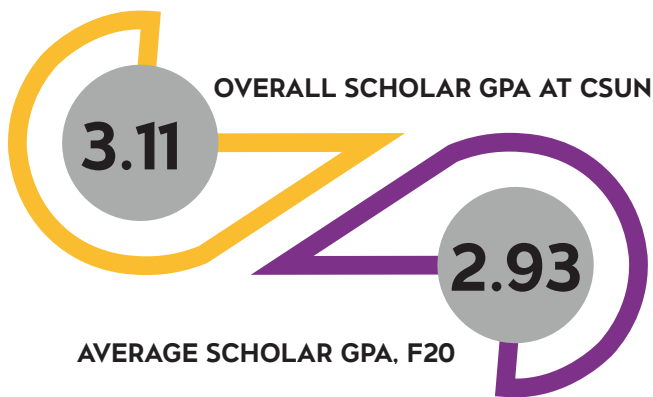

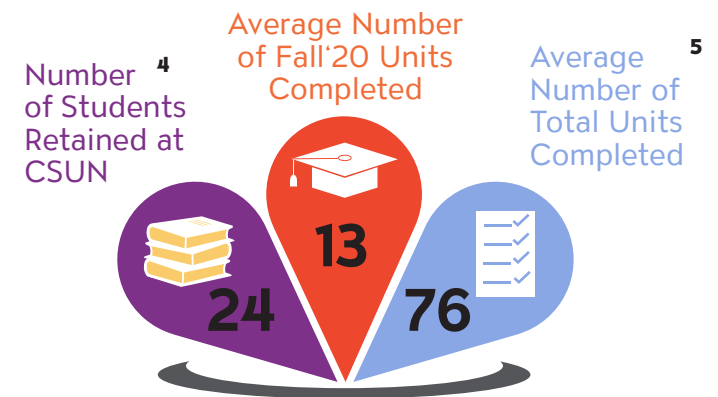
CHARACTERISTICS OF BRIDGE TO THE FUTURE STUDENTS



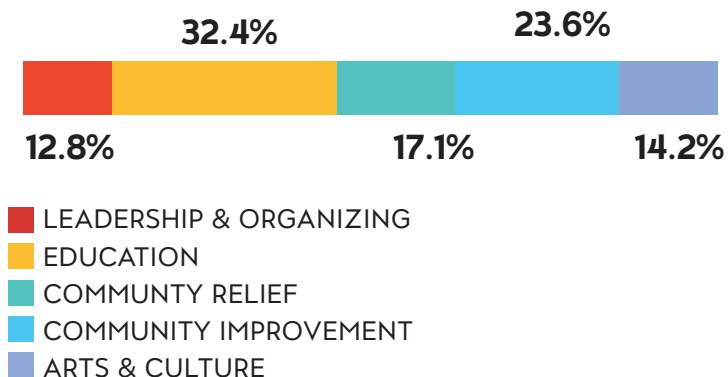
AVERAGE SCHOLAR GPA



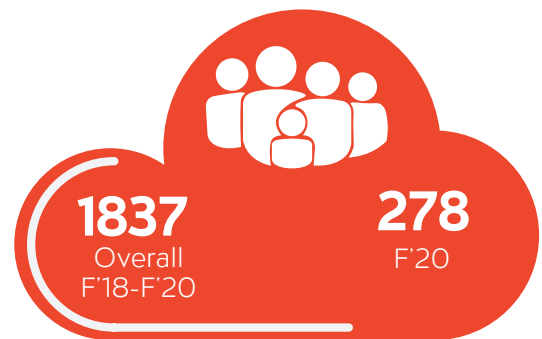
SCHOLAR ACCOMPLISHMENTS
