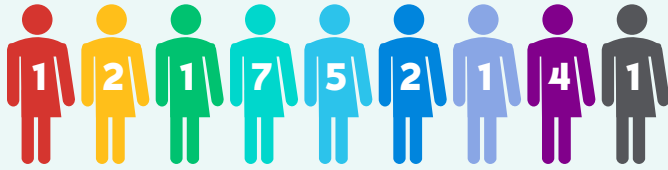

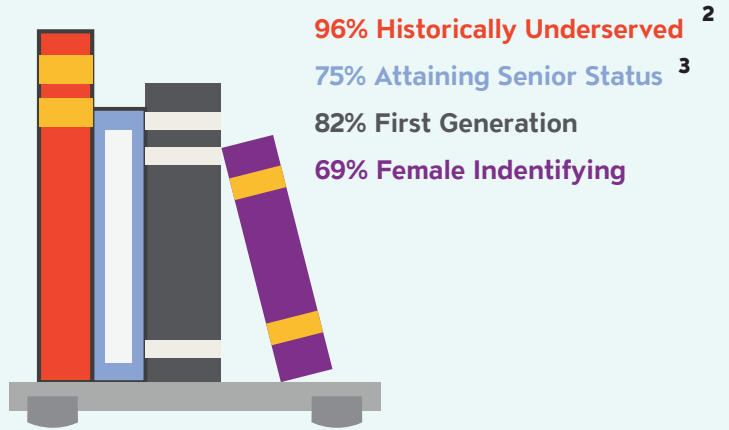

#### NUMBER OF STUDENTS ENROLLED BY COLLEGE

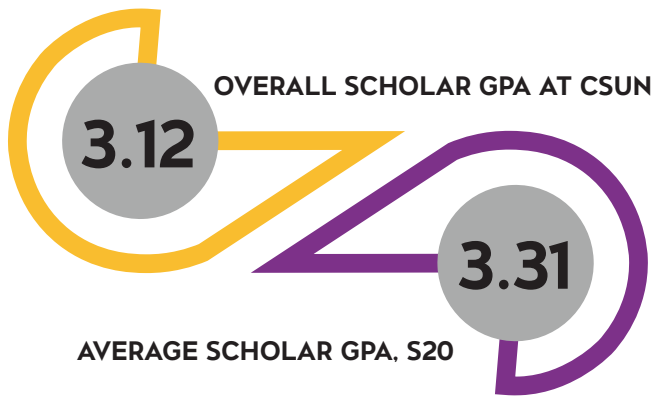

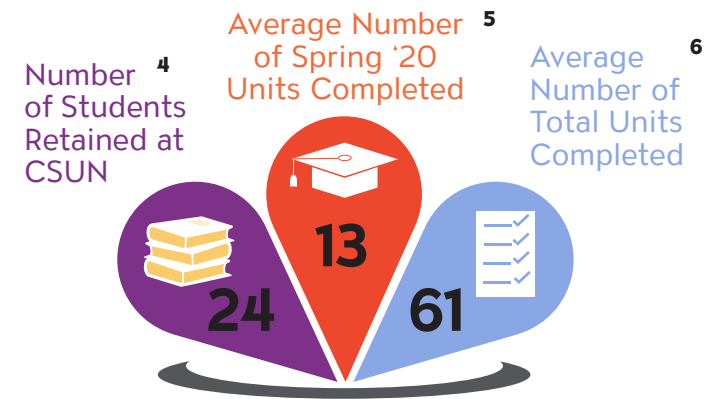
#### CHARACTERISTICS OF BRIDGE TO THE FUTURE STUDENTS



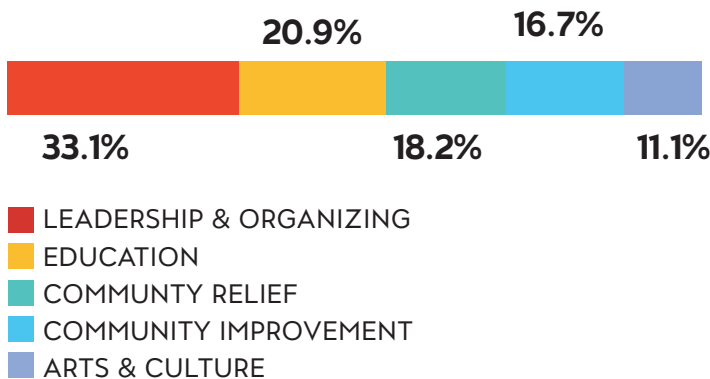
#### AVERAGE SCHOLAR GPA



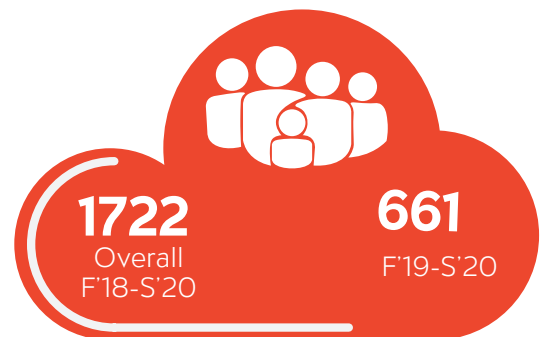
