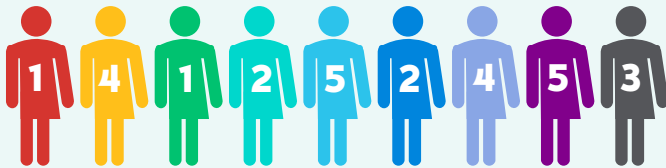

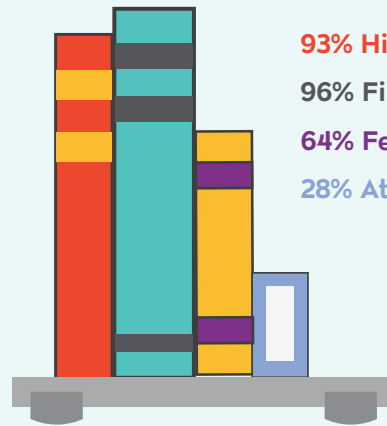

#### NUMBER OF STUDENTS ENROLLED BY COLLEGE



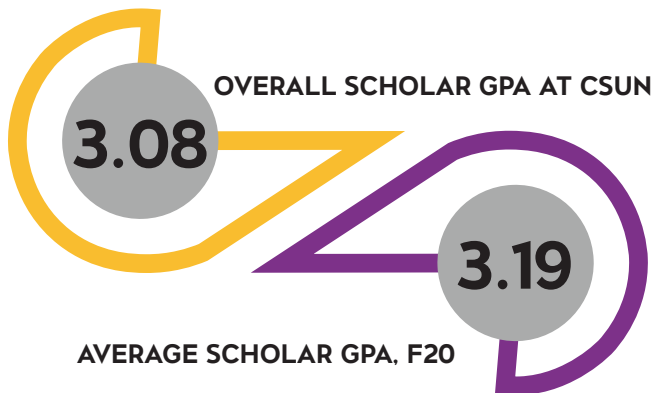

#### CHARACTERISTICS OF BRIDGE TO THE FUTURE STUDENTS

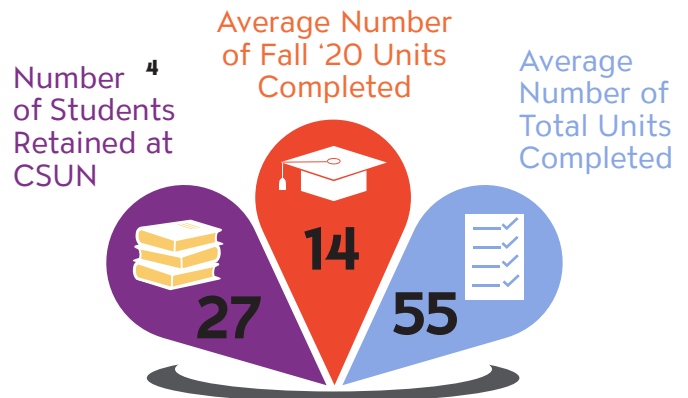


- 93% Historically Underserved<sup>2</sup>

- 28% Attaining Junior Status<sup>3</sup>

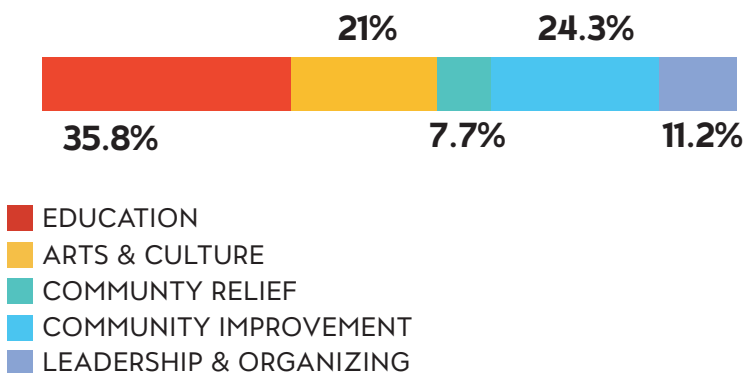
#### AVERAGE SCHOLAR GPA



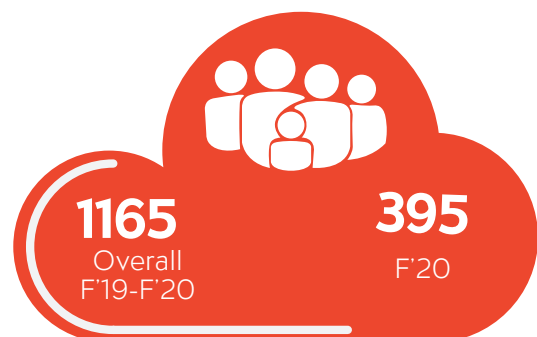
