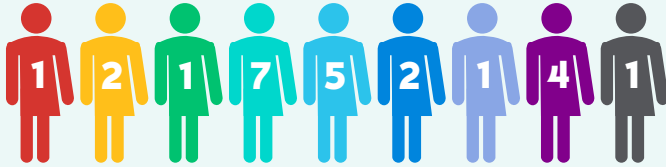

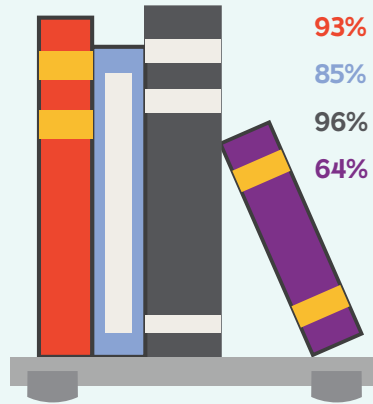

NUMBER OF STUDENTS ENROLLED BY COLLEGE

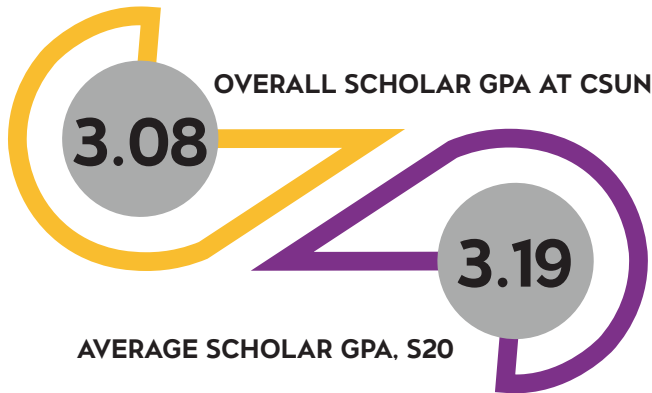

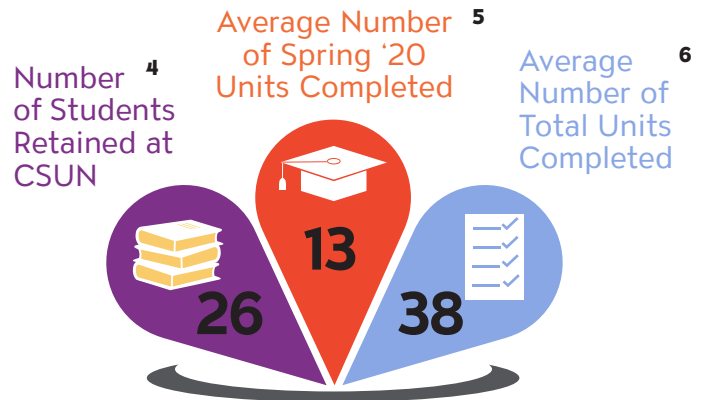

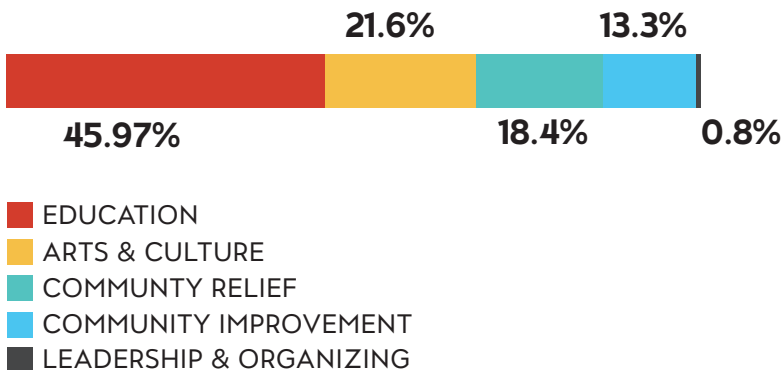
AVERAGE SCHOLAR GPA
