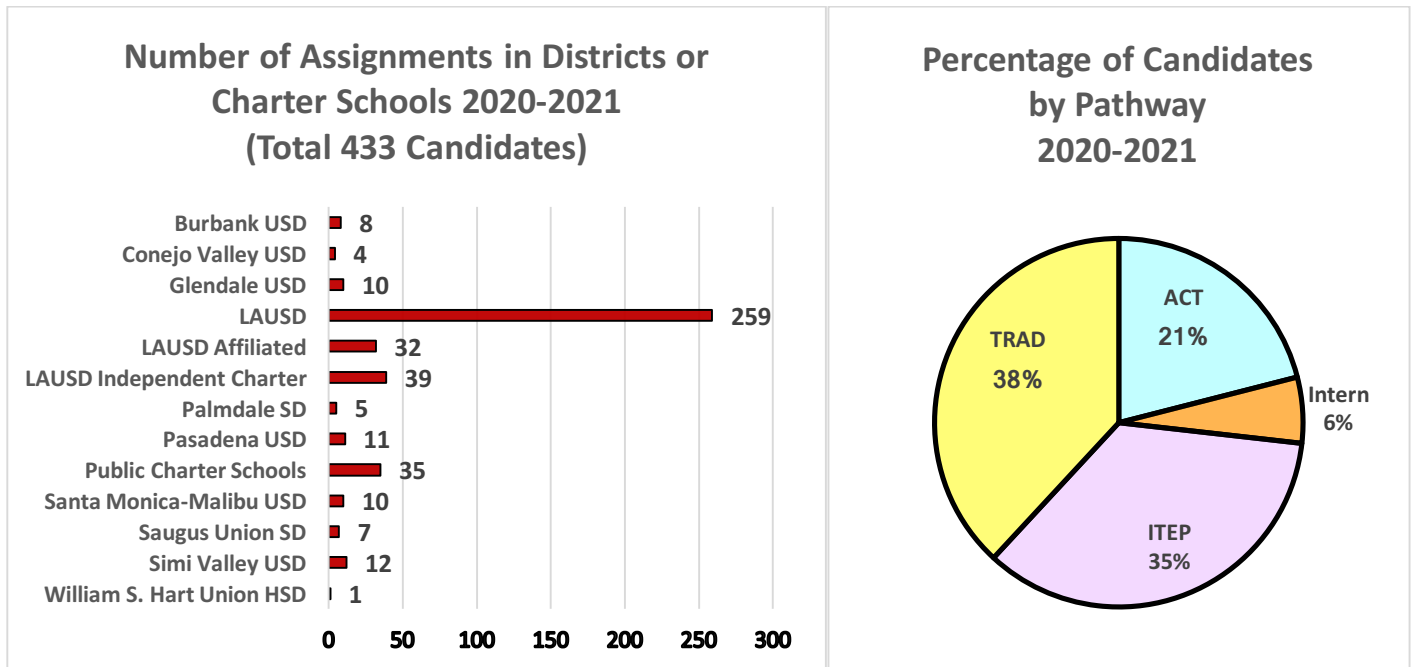

Featuring the Elementary Education Credential Program

Did You Know That...

The Department of Elementary Education made 433 placements during the 2020-21 academic year: 186 placements in Fall 2020 and 247 placements in Spring 2021. Candidates participated in four credential pathways: part- or full-time traditional (TRAD) program, 1-year full-time cohort-based Accelerated Collaborative Teacher (ACT) program, 2-year Intern Program for on-the-job teachers, or the undergraduate Integrated Teacher Education Program (ITEP). Candidates were placed primarily in Los Angeles Unified School District (LAUSD) and public charter schools. A total of 128 district and charter schools served elementary education candidates during 2020-21.
