




## **Featuring the Elementary Education Credential Program**

## Did You Know That...

The Department of Elementary Education made 415 placements during the 2022-23 academic year: 223 placements in Fall 2022 and 192 placements in Spring 2023. Candidates participated in four credential pathways: the part- or full-time traditional (TRAD) program, the 1-year full-time cohort-based Accelerated Collaborative Teacher (ACT) program, the 2-year Intern Program for on-the-job teachers, or the undergraduate Integrated Teacher Education Program (ITEP). Candidates were placed primarily in Los Angeles Unified School District (LAUSD) schools, including LAUSD Affiliated Charter and Independent Charter Schools.
