

Featuring the Elementary Education Credential Program

Did You Know That...

The Department of Elementary Education made 353 placements during the 2023-24 academic year: 189 placements in Fall 2023 and 164 placements in Spring 2024. Candidates participated in four credential pathways: the part- or full-time traditional (TRAD) program, the 1-year full-time cohort-based Accelerated Collaborative Teacher (ACT) program, the 2-year Intern Program for on-the-job teachers, or the undergraduate Integrated Teacher Education Program (ITEP). Candidates were placed primarily in Los Angeles Unified School District (LAUSD) schools, including LAUSD Affiliated Charter and Independent Charter Schools.
