MAJOR GRANT OBJECTIVES

(Grant Funded by the US Department of Education)

Objective 1: By Sept. 30, 2021, the failure rate of Latino students in gateway courses at COC, LA Pierce & CSUN will have improved a minimum of 3% per year over Fall, 2017 baselines.

Objective 2: By Sept. 30, 2021, 100 % Latino & low-income students in the program will participate in library resources/textbook lending program.

Objective 3: By Sept. 30, 2021, 100% of COC, LAP & CSUN students in this program will participate in career workshops, internship & service learning opportunities.

Objective 4: By Sept. 30, 2021, AS degrees for upper division transfer articulation agreements between COC, LAP & CSUN will be in place for the identified high demand career options.

Objective 5: By Sept. 30, 2021, outreach to high schools will result in an increase of 25% in the number of Latino & low-income students who select an AS degree & transfer in high demand career options.

Objective 6: By Sept. 30, 2021, 100% of COC, LA Pierce & CSUN students in this program will receive peer tutoring & mentoring.
