3. Courses that incorporate health disparities into biomedical research courses
4. Public Health for Social Justice (community colleges only)

- ✚ BUILD PODER will provide **\$5000** to faculty members who would like to develop a course for BUILD PODER and then shepherd the course to approved at all university levels, ensuring that the course is offered within 1-1 ½ years.

Please describe: Need and significance of course (100-250 words). Description of new course including: (a) Course title, (b) # of units, (c) prerequisites and co-requisites, (d) Course description, (e) Number of times course may be taken, (f) C-classification, (g) How course meets the research needs of students interested in biomedical careers, (h) books, websites, and other likely resources for course development and for the students, (i) who will teach the course, and (j) semester the course will be first taught.
