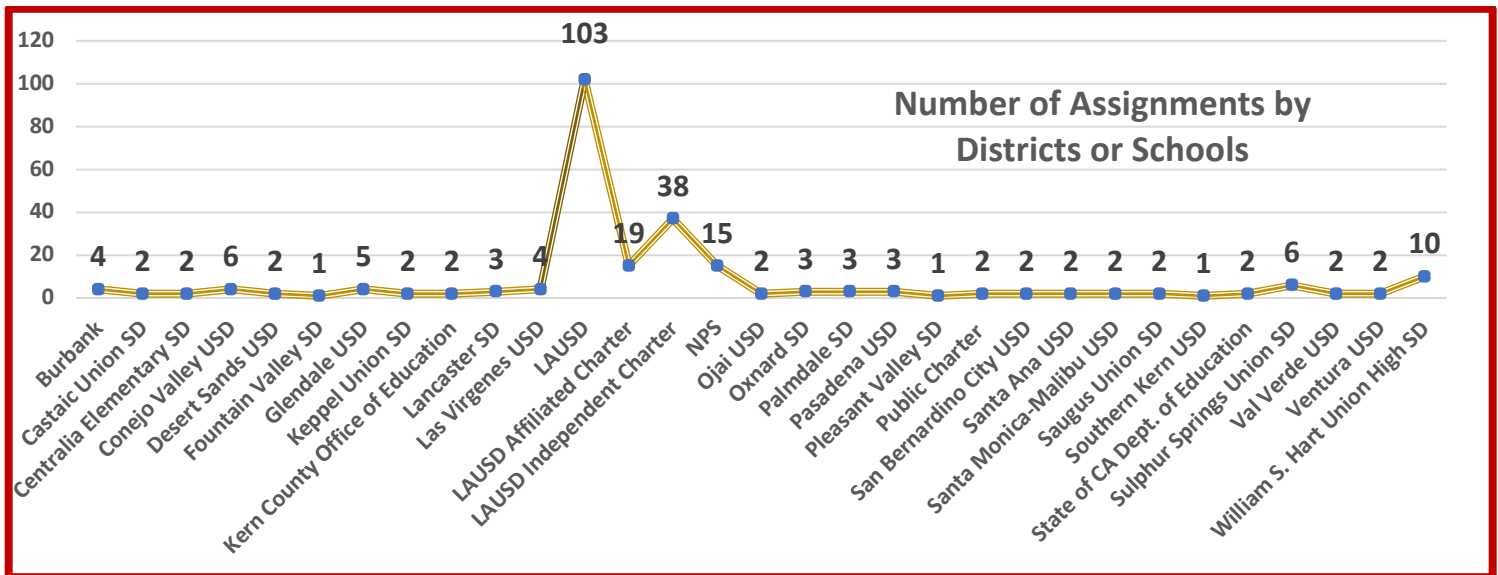
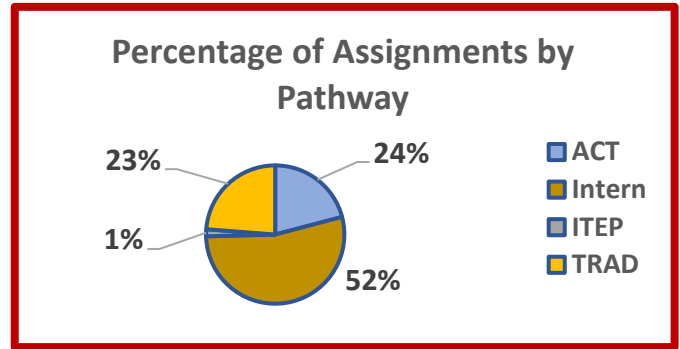
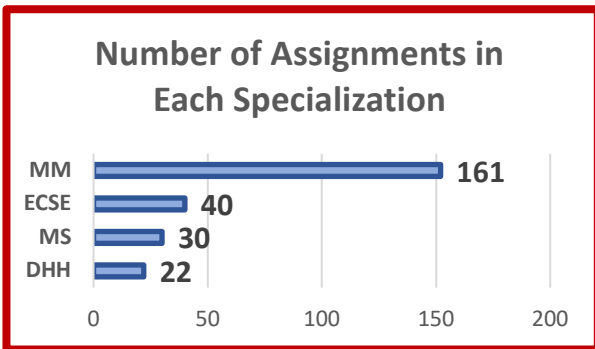

Did You Know That...

The Department of Special Education placed credential candidates in 253 field assignments during the 2021-2022 academic year (112 Fall 2021 and 141 Spring 2022). These assignments served credential candidates in four specializations (mild/moderate, moderate/severe, early childhood special education, deaf/hard of hearing) and four credential pathways (1-year full-time ACT Residency Program, full or part-time TR AD Program, 2-year on-the-job Intern Program, undergraduate ITEP Program).
