





## **Featuring the Special Education Credential Program**

## Did You Know That...

The Department of Special Education placed credential candidates in 190 field assignments during the 2022-2023 academic year (102 Fall 2022 and 88 Spring 2023). These assignments served credential candidates in five specialization areas (deaf/hard of hearing, early childhood special education, mild/moderate, mild/moderate to extensive needs, moderate/severe) and four credential pathways (1-year full-time ACT Residency Program, full or part-time TRAD Program, 2-year on-the-job Intern Program, undergraduate ITEP Program).
