



- Design from the beginning
- Training and consultation is available







Academic Standards

Students with disabilities should be evaluated by the same academic standards as students who are non-disabled. Accommodations do not change the faculty expectations or standards set for the course.

Accommodations

- DRES & NCOD designated to determine
- Documentation of disability on file confidential, released only per FERPA
- Consult with faculty and/or chair when academic standards appear in conflict
- Student Access and Accommodation System (SAAS) – online system to manage accommodations
- Communication Access System (CAS)


SAAS – Online System

- Provide media file(s) via Box folder
- NCOD will process captioning requests to completion

for NCOD students enrolled in their course(s).



Current Reality Issues

- NCOD & DRES predominately working remotely UDC working remotely
- Alternative Testing for on-campus exams only, by appointment only and must have 5 day lead time
- Faculty control additional testing time for online exams
- Respondus LockDown Browser can cause inaccessibility and disability related mannerisms can cause false flagging in AI monitoring systems
- Students may need faculty assistance with Note Sharing
- NCOD will need Zoom class links for service providers (interpreters/captionists)
- Student requests for mask exemptions due to a disability should be referred to DRES
