The California State University, Northridge Department of Police Services is providing this notice of criminal activity that occurred in our community in order to provide information that may help in avoiding similar crimes or provide information that may lead to an arrest.

Bicycle and Scooter Thefts

DATE: Between Sunday August 25, 2024 and Thursday August 29, 2024.

LOCATIONS: Parking Structure G6, BookStein Hall, Redwood Hall, University Park Apartments, and University Village Apartments

REPORTED OFFENSE: Five (5) bicycles (two electric) and one (1) electric scooter were stolen.

With students and faculty returning for the fall semester, please remember to secure your property, including bicycles, scooters, skateboards, backpacks/personal items, and electronics.
