


### CSU Fully Online Courses at California State University, Northridge

Welcome to CSU, **Northridge** (**CSUN**)! Now that you have enrolled in a CSUN Fully Online course, we'd like to share some advice and resources to help you prepare and succeed.

You are a student at CSUN with a CSUN student ID number and access to the CSUN Portal, your <u>CSUN</u> <u>Gmail</u> account, the free <u>CSUN Mobile App</u> and more. To get started:

- Set up your portal and email access: <u>Activating Your CSUN Account</u> or <u>CSUN Account Info</u>.
- Select MyCSUN from the top menu at <u>www.csun.edu</u> to reveal the login panel pictured below. Use the same CSUN user ID and password to log in to the portal, email, Canvas, Zoom, etc.
- Check your CSUN email regularly for important messages.



### Fall 2024 Key Dates at CSUN

Please note these dates from CSUN's <u>Registration Calendar</u> (you must abide by CSUN deadlines):

- Fri.-Sat. and Sat.-only classes begin Aug. 24, 2024. Weekday classes begin Mon., Aug. 26.
- Last day to drop a class online using self-service registration: Sun., Sept. 22.\*
- Last day of formal instruction: Tues., Dec. 10.
- Final exams week: Wed. to Tues., Dec. 12 to 17. Grades are available starting: Tues., Dec. 12.
- Holidays : Sept. 2 (Labor Day); Nov. 11 (Veteran's Day); Nov. 28 to Dec. 1 (Thanksgiving).

\*To **DROP** your CSU Fully Online course after enrolling, take these steps to **avoid a failing grade**:

- On or before Sept. 22, 2024, drop online in self-service registration. See the Drop a Class Guide.
- After Sept. 22, formal approval and form(s) are required. See Late Schedule Changes.

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#### Grades, Academic Standing & Transcripts

- The **grade** you earn for your CSUN fully online course will be reported automatically to your home CSU as transfer credit. You must drop your CSUN class by the deadline on page 1 or request formal approval to drop after the deadline to avoid <u>a grade of WU</u> (unauthorized withdrawal), which will count as an F. Be sure to formally drop the class!
- Your **academic standing** at CSUN will also count. If you receive a D, F or WU grade at CSUN, you could be put on <u>academic notice</u> or become disqualified even if you remain in good standing at your home CSU. Academic notice or disqualification will become part of your permanent academic record.
- If the course allows it, you can change the **grading basis** from a letter grade to <u>Credit/No Credit</u> before Sept. 22. Just be aware of the possible consequences. Learn more at <u>Change Grade Basis Guide</u>.
- As a student at CSUN, you'll need to <u>order a CSUN transcript</u> for this fully online class for future academic endeavors such as transferring or graduate school.

  - Find Canvas tutorials and the Canvas App for Students download at <u>Canvas Guides</u>.
- 2. Your professor might use <u>Zoom at CSUN</u>.
- 3. Review the professor's **syllabus** for course assignments and requirements, office hours, etc.
- 4. You can buy **course materials** for your CSU Fully Online class from the <u>CSUN Campus Store</u>. Assigned textbooks and materials are listed in the syllabus. Helpful: <u>Find Textbooks in Class Search Guide</u>
- 5. Take advantage of the <u>CSUN University Library online resources and services</u>, including 24/7 live chat. <u>MERLOT</u>, a curated collection of open-access textbooks and resources, is also available to you.
