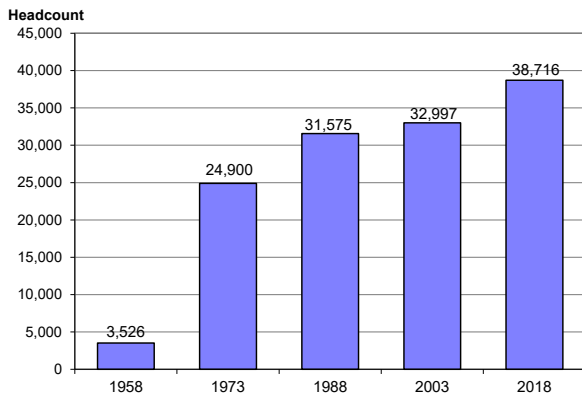

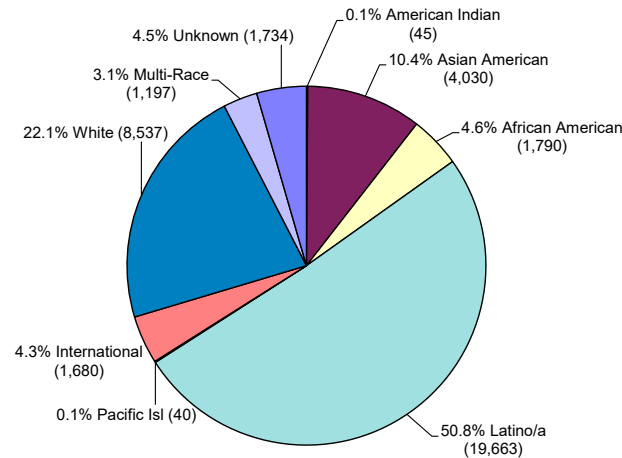

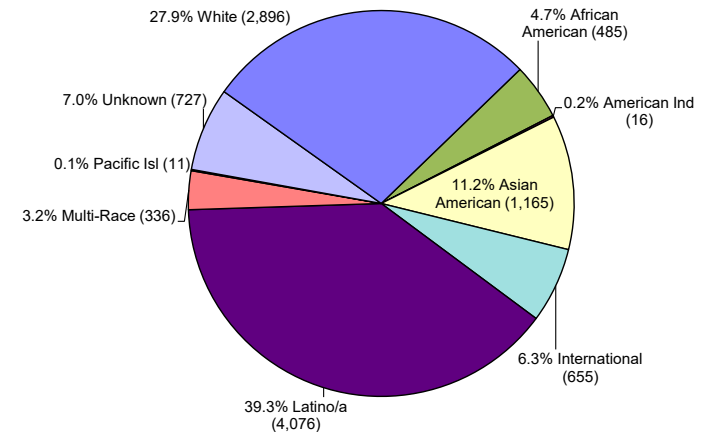

Degree Recipient Ethnicity



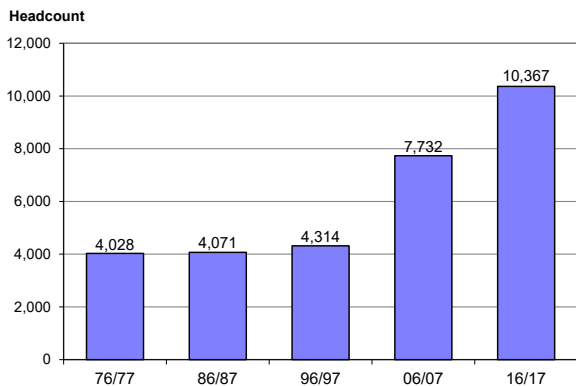

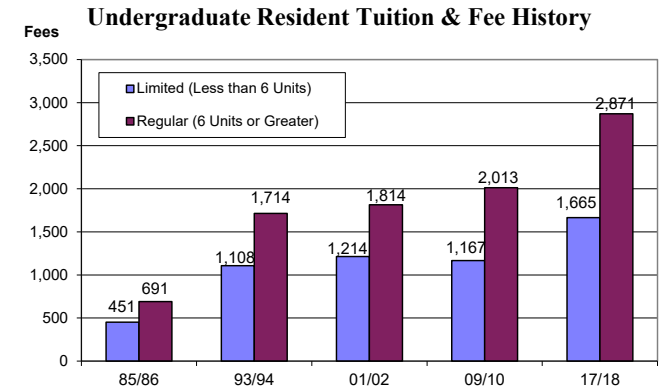

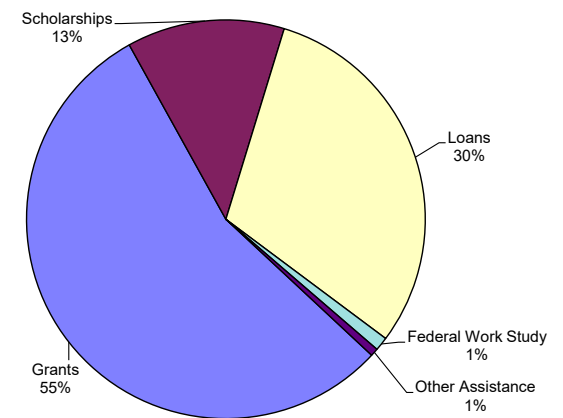
Tuition & Financial Aid 2017/18
