Read the Annex of <u>NSTISSI No. 4011</u> (pp. 18-26) on the Information Systems Security Model. I have also provided a figure of the <u>Security Model</u> that is not included in the 4011 document. Be prepared to discuss the CIA triad as well as the two other dimensions of the model.
